

# Newsletter archive API

- Display a dynamic newsletter archive in your website or any other website.
- It takes 5 lines of code to implement it.

### SET-UP

1. Create a folder "api" next to admin folder.
2. Place files loadMenu.asp and loadNewsletter.asp in the api folder.
3. Place file newsletter.js inside admin/scripts folder.
4. In the <head> part of the page where you want to show the archive add the following <script> blocks (3 lines):

```
<script language="JavaScript" type="text/javascript">var url="http://www.yourdomain.com/nmanagerpro/";</script>
<script src="http://www.yourdomain.com/nmanagerpro/admin/scripts/newsletter.js" type="text/javascript"></script>
<script language="JavaScript" type="text/javascript">Event.observe(window, 'load', function() { loadMenu() });</script>
```

Replace the yellow parts with your own actual URL to your Newsletter Manager Pro installation.

**The following line loads a drop-down menu for selecting a newsletter:**

```
<div align="center" id="menuDiv" style="margin: 20px auto;"></div>
```

**And this line loads the newsletter you select with the menu.**

```
<div align="center" id="holderDiv" style="margin: 10px auto;height:100%;width:800px;"></div>
```

The page newsletters.html serves as example. You can use any other page.

**Note:** Only newsletters that are marked as **public** appear in the archive.
